"My case I have been on work cover after being bullied insistently in the work place. I know that the lawyers work hand in hand with the insurance companies to kill the claim as soon as possible. I have been told by my lawyers it is impossible to win a bullying claim, I feel this is wrong and if you have the evidence and can produce that evidence WHY is that so! I was bullied out of my job in 2014, I have not yet been to consolation 5 years on"
