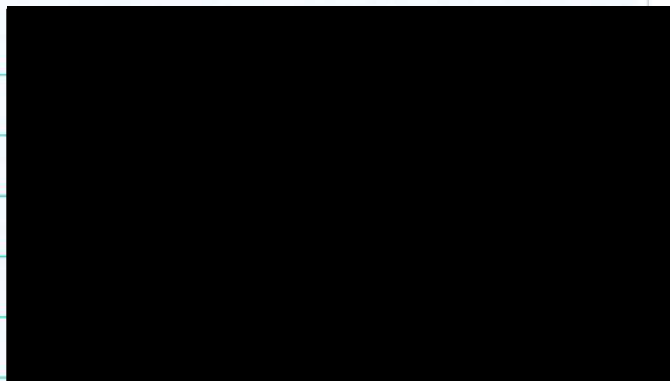

In Feb/March approx I was
arrested by Vic Police at
my unit [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] [REDACTED] for a crime I did not
commit under the terms of a
'Miscarriage of Justice'
I was dragged into the
[REDACTED] Psych Ward
and was told in common area
of Seclusion that I would get
an injection which I refused
told to stand and wait for
doctor I saw up to a dozen
Psych Workers put on gloves
coming for me I fainted fearing
the worst I had all my clothes
ripped off me and put on a
straight jacket.

I had many needles
put into me and received
many punches and kicks to
the body and head before I
lost consciousness waking up
approx 22 hours later in
a Seclusion Cell in a large
pool of blood, I then was
taken out of Straight Jacket
and given a standard Blue green
pair of Pyjamas and put into
a High Dependency Cell where I
tried to strangle or hang myself
I tried to make a genuine cry
for help for my innocence In June
2006 my Lawyer [REDACTED]
was murdered he was hoping to
represent and appeal on a no win

I wrote to Buckingham Palace
to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth
on a Parlor Plea a Petition for
Mercy for a Royal Pardon

Her Majesty thru Miss Terry

of Buckingham Palace said
Her Majesty has lost a lot
of her powers to Australia
and only now referred to a
Constitutional Sovereign but
with nature of my allegations
referred the nature of complaint
to the Governor General his excellency

 even refer my calls ^{as} as a
 nuisance call

Any amount of help I can
 get ~~if~~ I am humble I am
 currently under [REDACTED]
~~but waiting~~ but waiting for seven
 months now since Jan 2019 for
 Break thru Services to ~~find~~ for
 me.

many got no where to go.

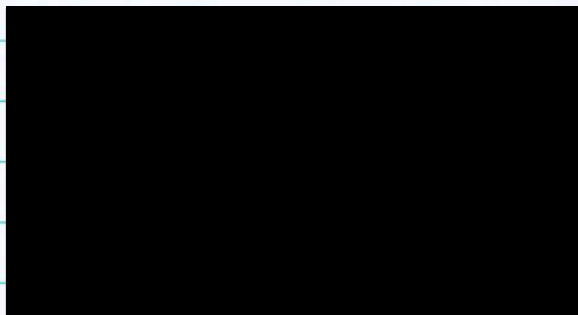
