Dear Mr Dedlefs

Thank you for your letter of 27 March 2018 to the Attorney-General, the Hon Christian Porter MP, with regard to your concerns about Kelvin Dedlefs and an incident at [REDACTED] Employment Support Services. The Attorney-General has asked me to reply to you on his behalf.

I am very sorry to hear about your difficulties. The Attorney-General and the Attorney-General's Department are unable to provide legal advice to individual members of the community.

You suggest in your letter that you have previously contacted the Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission (now known as the Australian Human Rights Commission) and that it is unable to help you with your case. While the Australian Human Rights Commission is the independent national statutory body responsible for administering the Disability Discrimination Act 1992, it retains the discretion to choose not to pursue the cases that are brought to its attention.

KELVIN WAS THREATENED, HELD, N SEARCHED

If you have concerns you wish to raise about how the Commission handled your matter, or you are dissatisfied with the manner in which your complaint was handled, you may wish to raise these concerns directly with the President of the Commission, Professor [REDACTED] AM. 14. There was no real pattern to the thefts so to be 100% sure we felt that we would need to ask the employees to stay back and ask to search their bags if it happened again. We wanted to treat everyone exactly the same until we were 100% sure of the culprit.

Mr DEDLEFS believes the Claimant does not have the ability to give permission for such things as being asked to stay back at work or asked to have his bag searched. [REDACTED]

Mr DEDLEFS reiterated throughout the interview he did not want money from the WorkCover process he only wanted the claim to be accepted to pay for any future psychological treatment of Kelvin if required.

Mr DEDLEFS acknowledged he had completed the Claimant's Workers Injury Claim form on behalf of the Claimant. The Claimant agreed his signature was on the form.

Mr DEDLEFS indicates on the Workers Injury Claim form the Claimant's 'daily function was degraded' by Mr [REDACTED].

"CEO IS A BULLY OF DISABLED"

Mr [REDACTED] stated as the CEO he does not have daily interaction with the Claimant or any of the workers.

Mr DEDLEFS wrote on the Workers Injury Claim form the Claimant left the Employer because he was afraid of Mr [REDACTED].

Mr [REDACTED] asserts the Claimant remained with the Employer for six (6) months after the alleged injury on 5 October 2009. Mr [REDACTED] states the Claimant has always acknowledged him if they came across each other's paths at the Employers site.

MR DEDLEFS wrote on the Workers Injury Claim form the Claimant was searched by the CEO on 5 October 2009.

YOUR THE CEO DON'T BLAME OTHERS

Mr [REDACTED] stated he was not present at the [REDACTED] Work Area at approximately 3:00pm on 5 October 2009.

We act for Mr. and Mrs. Dedlefs, who have instructed us in relation to their son Kelvin who works at the above centre.

We are instructed that on 1 October 2009 a memo was circulated by [REDACTED] to all [REDACTED] workers stating that there had recently been thefts from the female locker rooms and if there was another occurrence of theft "the police will be called and no one will be allowed to leave the building". On 5 October 2009 at 3.00pm a member of the support staff, namely [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] workers that there had been another theft and no workers would be allowed to leave the centre until the thief was exposed and their bags would be searched. Workers were also threatened that the Police would be called. We have been further instructed that Kelvin felt very intimidated and scared and believed that he was not able to leave the centre. In fact, with his limited understanding, he believed that he was under arrest.

Our client sent you a letter on 6 October 2009 detailing his grievances with the actions taken by support staff on 5 October 2009. We have been provided with a copy of your reply dated 8 October 2009 and are instructed to respond as follows:
